

Caring for your new Copper Sink

Copper sinks from MoSER are easy to care for, are virtually maintenance free and come with a limited lifetime warranty. Copper sinks do not require harsh chemical cleaning, and with proper care, their beauty will last a lifetime.

The beauty of copper is its living finish or patina. It builds over time and works as a protective coating. The patina is a rich weathered finish with light and dark tones complementing each other and creating the unique effect of copper.

Daily basic preventive maintenance

Wash with mild soap such as dawn, water and a soft cloth or sponge and once finished, wipe off the surface to remove standing water. Acidic foods such as ketchup, tomato juice, lemons should be cleaned as soon as possible as they can create shiny spots. If this happens, do not worry as this is only cosmetic. Your sink has not be harmed or damaged in any way. Over time and with daily use, the copper will heal itself and the color will begin to return to its original shade. For extra protection or to slow the patina process, you can use a high quality carnauba wax, however this is not something we feel is mandatory.

Additional Potential hazards to avoid

- i NEVER USE abrasive products such as Soft Scrub, Steel Wool, Chore Girl to clean your sink as they can scratch the surface and temporarily remove the patina.
- ii NEVER USE harsh chemicals such as Brasso, Clorox, Drano or Similar Products.
- iii Using your sinks as a cutting board. This type of use can lead to deep scratches in the sink. Always use a cutting board.
- iv Allowing chemicals to sit in your sink. Chemicals such as sulfuric acid, hydrochloric acid are present in many products such as drain cleaners and silver dip cleaners. If these products are accidently spilled onto the copper sink surface, immediately rinse and clean the sink.
